1. The Great Rescue Gallery, Chile

One of the most astonishing rescues of recent times – of the 33 miners trapped for more than two months in the San Jose mine – is commemorated in this new gallery opened to mark the first anniversary of the rescue. The dedicated room at the Museo de Colchagua in **Santa Cruz** tells the story of the miners' ordeal. Three of them have contributed to the exhibition which, as well as offering an insight into the their working life, focuses on the rescue operation.
